Health Hazards(Acute and Chronic):

General:

Toxicity information is not available for this compounded material. This health Hazard assessment is based on information available for the individual ingredients in the compound. No specific information is available regarding the chronic effects of exposure to this compound . However , one of the hazardous decomposition products , formaldehyde , is considered a potential cancer hazard by OSHA , NTP and IARC , (see OSHA recommended exposure limits shown below).

Inhalation :

No toxic effects are known to be associated with the inhalation or ingestion of airborne respirable frbers during machining operations such as cutting, machining, grinding, crushing or sanding. However, particular fillers can irritate upper respiratory passages. Repeated and prolonged inhalation of excessive concentration of respirable fiber may cause permanent lung injury.

Machining procedures should be reviewed to assure that particulate levels are kept below recommended exposure limits listed below. Inhaling fumes of decompostion products can cause temporary influenza-like symptoms described as "Polymer Fume Fever" and may include but not be limited to : fever , cough and malaise.
